In partnership with the University at Buffalo Regional Institute and partners from across the region, we created *Goodskills Career Builder*, a research-based training program that will redefine workforce development in our region and directly support thousands of underemployed and unemployed individuals in our region. This new initiative that provides training and job placement in the growing manufacturing and technology fields. Goodskills prioritizes targeted skills and credentials that lead individuals to a higher wage career path or into an advanced training program in just four weeks.

And finally, Goodwill of Western New York remained strong in 2020 thanks to the continued support of our generous shoppers and donors. Nearly one million pounds of donated clothing and merchandise came through our doors last year resulting in 1,752,549 items sold.
